

# BKHS King Henry VIII Sixth Form Dress Code

At the pinnacle of their school career and the strongest ambassadors for our school Sixth Form students are always expected to be well presented with a business-like appearance when representing the school. Suits for this purpose can be purchased from high street retailers but must be bought as a suit and not as individual pieces. The Sixth Form Team and Senior Management may ask the student to return home if their attire is considered unsuitable.

## Skirt Suit

Skirt or trouser suit in a dark colour - pinstripes or checks are acceptable. A dress suit is also allowed. All pieces must be made of the same fabric and be designed to be worn together. Skirt length should be no more than 10cm above the knee. Trousers can be ankle length. Stretch fabric and tight-fitting skirts or trousers are not allowed.

Blouse with collar or uncollared and sleeves. Plain, pastel colours and moderate patterns. See-through fabrics and sleeveless designs are unacceptable.

Black or dark coloured shoes or ankle boots with heels no higher than 5cm.

School pin (from Sixth Form office).

Plain, dark or natural coloured tights. Socks, patterned tights and bare legs are not permitted.

Discrete make-up and natural nails (no acrylics) with pale nail varnish only permitted.



## Trouser Suit

Suit in a dark colour - faint pinstripes or checks are acceptable. All pieces must be made of the same fabric and be designed to be worn together.

Shirt with collar and sleeves. Plain, pastel colours and moderate patterns. Cufflinks are acceptable.

School or Representative tie.

Black or dark coloured shoes or ankle boots worn with socks.

Must be clean shaven or have a manicured beard.

Plain dark coloured socks.

## Commonalities

Thin knit jumper in a single colour with V or round neck. A jacket must be worn over this on the main school site.

Discreet jewellery and removed for Games. No piercings, except ear lobes - only one pair of small stud earrings.

Hair should be of a natural colour and moderate style.

Coats in plain design and dark colours.
